THE POLICY ACT AND COPYRIGHT LAWS  
**PROHIBIT** THE USE OF:

- 👉 ANY VIDEO AND AUDIO RECORDING DEVICES (INCLUDING SMART PHONES AND TABLETS)
- 👉 MOBILE PHONES – please ensure they are turned off before entering the venue
- 👉 FLASHLIGHTS
- 👉 ELECTRONIC GAMES OF ANY SORT

***Such devices may be confiscated for the duration of the session***

## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. Unless otherwise stated, the Burdekin Junior Eisteddfod is for amateur performers only i.e. any person who does not derive nor has ever derived his or her main income or a substantial income as a teacher and/or performer in the particular category for which he/she wishes to enter. Confirmation may be requested in writing from a student teacher presently studying and/or teaching under guidance of professional teachers, in the case of a dispute.
2. Entries close: 13<sup>th</sup> March 2022. No late entries will be accepted.
3. Entries are available online at [www.stardom.com.au](http://www.stardom.com.au)
4. The age of the competitors will be as at the date of the Eisteddfods commencement (8<sup>th</sup> May 2022). The Executive reserves the right to call upon any competitor or school to furnish a birth certificate or copy thereof and to withhold any prize until such certificate has been furnished.
5. In sections where entry is by school year, competitors who have left school are still eligible to enter as long as they are under the stated age limit.
6. Entry fees are not refundable unless the section is cancelled by the committee, or there is an error in programming.
7. Only one (1) entry will be accepted from a competitor per section.
8. No entry will be accepted if payment is not made in full.
9. The committee has the power to decide any question not contained in these rules and regulations.
10. Unless otherwise stated, any one item may be performed once only by a competitor during the Eisteddfod.
11. The committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any section/s.
12. The decision of the adjudicator is final.
13. Prompting, except by an adjudicator is not permitted.
14. Intending competitors who have been pupils of an adjudicator within six months prior to Eisteddfod start date will be ineligible to enter any section judged by the adjudicator. (Workshops/Guest Teachers excluded)
15. Unless specifically invited by the adjudicator, contact must not be made directly by teachers, competitors or parents.
16. Any item having to withdraw after entering must notify the committee as soon as possible to ensure smooth programming.



17. It is the performer's responsibility to check the program for performance dates and times. Updates for Visual Arts presentations will also be made on our website and Facebook.
18. Any protest or objection must be referred to the Co-ordinator of the section within 30 minutes of the Adjudicator's decision. A protest will only be accepted from a competitor, the competitor's teacher or parent and must be received in writing with a \$40 fee. Anonymous letters will NOT be considered. If the complaint is found to be valid, this fee will be refunded. In the case of a dispute arising in respect of the age of any competitor and his/her eligibility to appear in any age grouping, the committee reserves the right to request a copy of the competitors birth certificate.
19. Safety is paramount and every care will be taken to protect competitors, but the committee will not be responsible for any injuries sustained by any competitor and or damage to property during the Eisteddfod.
20. The committee has the right to amend the program at any time.
21. Competitors names and/or photographs may be used in the media. Should this not be appropriate please ensure the committee is notified. This can be completed via the media disclaimer on your Stardom entry.
22. Competitors can only enter sections in their own age group.
23. Inappropriate and suggestive movement, costuming and /or obscene language is not permitted. The Adjudicator may comment and/or penalise.
24. Failure to comply wholly or partly with any of the rules and regulations may result in disqualification or the withholding of prizes. The decision of the committee on any question or dispute shall be final.
25. Engraving of trophies is the responsibility of the awardee, except for perpetual trophies, as they are not taken home. The committee will arrange for all engraving of perpetual trophies and they will be displayed in the eisteddfod office.

## VISUAL & LITERARY ARTS

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### GENERAL:

All exhibits must be in the hands of the Entries Secretary by **5:00pm Thursday 14th April 2022 at 144b Young Street, Ayr.**

**NO LATE EXHIBITS WILL BE ACCEPTED - ADJUDICATION COMMENCES SATURDAY 15<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2022**

- All submissions must be the original work created by the competitor named on the entry form.
- All submissions must not have been entered in any previous eisteddfod.
- Only one entry per competitor per section is allowed. All entries, including special needs, are to be from an individual competitor
- Entrants are to use the template provided (*this can also be downloaded from the Burdekin Junior Eisteddfod Inc. website*) to record the Competitor's Number, Section, Title, Class at School and School Code.  
(The name of the school is NOT to appear on this form.)
- This template MUST be glued to the back of the completed piece of work.
  - Please mark works clearly on the template with the title, and details highlighted above
  - Exhibits MUST be collected from the foyer of Burdekin Theatre on the day of Awards. The Eisteddfod accepts no responsibility for entries not collected by this time and may endeavour to return uncollected entries to schools in the weeks after the Eisteddfod concludes if time permits. Literature not collected by June 30<sup>th</sup>, will be destroyed.

### LITERATURE

- The work may have been submitted as part of a school assignment.
- All literary works must be legible and submitted on A4 paper, written, or printed on one side only.
- All written works must be clearly titled when submitted – not necessarily on the entry form.
- Please note word limits. Submissions exceeding these limits will receive adjudication but may not receive a mark.
- A word count must be written at the end of each piece of work.



**FUNCTIONAL WRITING:**

Free selection including reports, editorials, interviews, human interest story, section of advertising campaign, news report, small play or feature article. Basically any written work excluding short story and poem. Clip Art, Publisher and Illustrations may be used to enhance presentation

**SIZES:**

Drawing and Collage must be on stiff paper, no larger than **A3 for Primary** and **1m x 1m for Secondary**. (A4 is acceptable.)

Paintings are to be on firm paper, board or canvas, no larger than **A3 for Primary** and **1m x 1m for Secondary**. (A4 is acceptable.)

Entrants are to use the template provided (this can also be downloaded from the Burdekin Junior Eisteddfod Inc. website) to record the Competitor's Number, Section, Title, Class at School and School Code. **(The name of the school is not to appear on this form.)** This template is then glued to the back of the completed piece of work.
